# MOROCCO

## Day One:

### Morning - Arrival

Arrival and traditional welcome at Marrakech Menara Airport with red roses presented to the ladies. Transfer to the hotel by luxury coach or horse and carriage

### Evening - The Old Medina

Begin your time in this ancient, enchanting city by taking a step back in time. Gather in a typical riad in the heart of the Old Medina to enjoy local specialities of couscous and tagine against a beguiling rhythm of Arabian - Andalusian music.

## Day Two:

### Morning - The Great Souks

Unravel the magical mystery of the Souks where everything from spices to shoes are available in a glorious mosaic of colour. Barter with crafty merchants, sample their culinary

offerings, then linger awhile over a relaxing mint tea on a private terrace overlooking the bustle of El F'na Square.

### Afternoon - Door to the Desert

Leave the hustle of the city behind and travel the rugged road to Ouarzazte through the spectacular scenery of the Dra'a Valley. Stop in the kasbah town of Ait Ben Haddou which, at a height of 1,160m, stands in stark contrast to this vast plateau. Originally a crossing point for traders crossing the Sahara Desert, this UNESCO world heritage site is equally recognised as the location for films such as 'Laurence of Arabia' and 'Gladiator'.

### Evening - Rock the Kasbah

Ouarzazte is the land of ancient palaces and kasbahs. This evening, behind the ancient fortress walls of the kasbah,

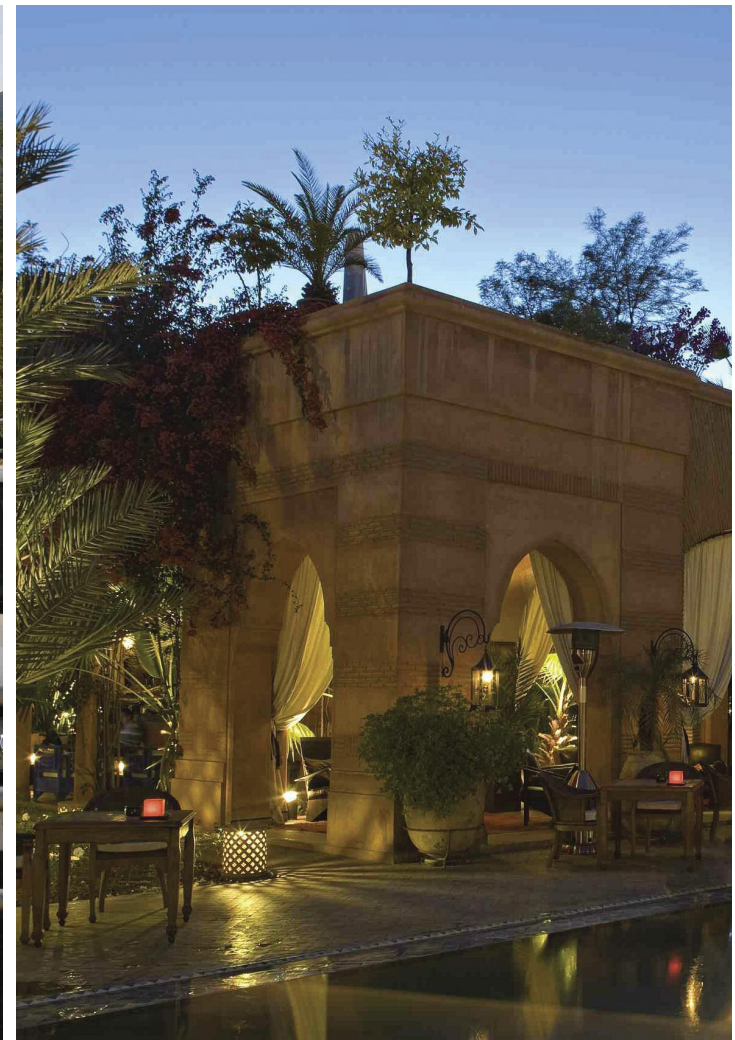
savour a traditional Moroccan feast while the heady, intoxicating beat of Berber drum music and song combines with local dance troupes to fuel the festive atmosphere

## Day Three: Zagora

Arrival at Zagora, a lush, inhabited oasis known for its delectable dates that grow on palm trees. Take to the dunes to explore the mystical Saharan landscape as you ride by camel over the sugar-fine sands to your purpose built Bedouin style campsite.

### Evening - 1001 nights under the stars

As the red sun sinks and night falls, relax at low tables on colourful carpets to watch traditional folkloric dance and listen as a local storyteller recalls the tales of 1001 nights



nights and legends of the desert. Delight in a feast of harira soup, a savoury tagine and exquisite Moroccan pastries.

#### **Day Four: Eco Experience**

Back on the road, or off road at least, cross the awe-inspiring Tiz'n'Test Pass to arrive at a charming ecolodge naturally created in adobe and wood. Spend the afternoon planting trees before sharing an intimate dinner with local Berbers happy to impart their customs and traditions over an intimate dinner.

#### **Day Five:**

Arise early to watch a spectacular sunrise over the Sahara desert before transferring to the airport for onward journey home.
