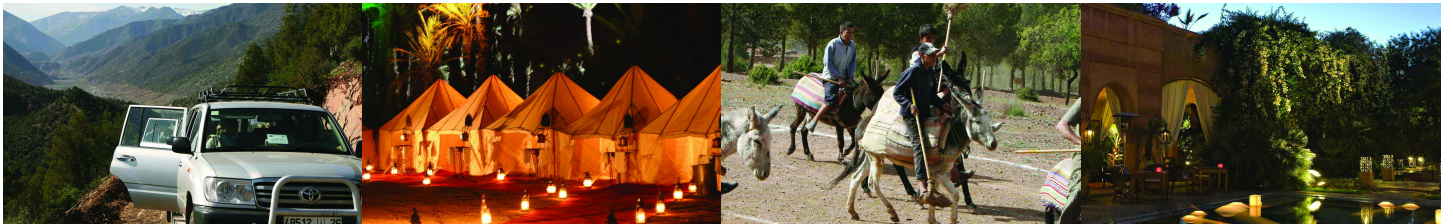


MEETING 3 nights

MARRAKECH

Day One:

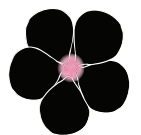
